District swimming in Lancefield \relay.


On Friday the 3 to 6's that made it through to the district swimming team went to represent Kilmore Primary school. At the end of the day

What is Conveyance Allowance? Conveyance Allowance is paid to parents/ guardians to assist with the transport cost of driving their child/ren to and from school.

Am I eligible for Conveyance Allowance? For student to be eligible for a Conveyance Allowance they must;

- •Be aged over 5 years by 30th April
- •Live more than 4.8 km by the shortest practicable route from the nearest bus stop, and
- •Be enrolled at the nearest government school.
