From the Principal's Desk...

Welcome to Week 7 Term 4

Another busy and productive week underway! Staff are beginning to see light at the end of the report writing tunnel.

On Thursday this week we have our final Pupil Free Day planned. The agenda is a very busy one with the focus being on bringing together the School Improvement Plan which has resulted from the priority review after consultation with staff and parents. On Thursday we will complete a document we are calling 'The Kilmore Primary School Way'. This document will outline the instructional model that will be used across the school to deliver Literacy, Numeracy and Inquiry. It will build on the solid foundations that exist at KPS and add depth to bring it in line with best practices in teaching and curriculum delivery. It will outline non-negotiables in terms of the learning environment, high expectations of student book work and core elements of literacy and numeracy. The document will help bring consistency across all grades in the school and will assist the induction of new staff so that the consistency is maintained even when staff turnover occurs. This is important work and will set the school up for a great start in 2016 as we implement the improvement strategies completely.

If you haven't sent one in and would like to, please do so as soon as possible. Send the letters in a sealed envelope addressed to me. Please remember that the task of creating grade groups is complex and many variables need to be considered. Salvation Army Christmas Appeal


