Swimming Trials

Meet the Teacher/Parent Information Nights

This year we are trying a new format for our meet the teacher/parent information evenings. We will be holding two evenings: **F-2 parents are invited to attend on Tuesday 10th February** and **Grade 3-6 parents are invited to attend on Thursday 12th February.** This is an opportunity to showcase our school and for you to meet your child's teacher and other families in our school.

The evening will commence with a presentation in the stadium at 6.30 pm. Following the presentation your child will be able to show you their classroom and introduce you to their teacher. Parents are welcome to visit the classroom anytime between 7pm and 8pm. Tea, coffee or a cold drink will be available in the stadium foyer during this time. As this is a general 'meet and greet' evening, there will not be time for individual interviews with parents. If you would like to discuss your child's learning with their teacher please arrange an appointment time with them.

Sunsmart

We are a Sunsmart school. Sun protection is used from **September to the end of April** or **whenever UV levels reach three or more.** Please ensure your child has a school hat at school each day and their own sunscreen to protect them from the sun.

A letter from the School Captains


Welcome back to school for 2015. So far, we have seen some good things happening:

Everyone has been sun smart and wearing their hats! The preps got off to a great start to the year! Everyone is playing nicely in the yard together. The first assembly of the year went great!





SWIMMING

Swimming Trials will be held on Friday 6th February at

the Kilmore Leisure Centre. Any students in grade 3, 4, 5 & 6 are eligible to ty out for the Kilmore Primary School Swim team for 2015. For children's own safety it is important to note that they should be confident in swimming 50 m without stopping in order to trial.

Students can trial in any of the 4 strokes – freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly.

Students will be put into age groups according to what they turn this year. Age groups are - 9/10 year old, 11 year old, and 12/13 year old. For example if your child is turning 10 this year they will compete in the 9/10 year age group. Students must be turning 9 this year in order to compete.

We will be walking down to the Kilmore Leisure Centre leaving at 12.00pm and returning at 3.00pm.

Permission form and money needs to be returned to school office by Thursday 5th February.
