Curriculum Day

Education Maintenance Allowance (EMA) Semester 2

If you hold a Health Care Card (current as at 14th July, 2014) and did not apply for the Education Maintenance Allowance at the beginning of the year, please call at the school office and complete a form for the second instalment.

Parents/guardians who applied for the first half of the year do not need to complete a second form as this is done automatically. However, if your health care card has expired since the first day of Term 1 (28th January 2014), you do need to present your new card to the school office for verification as soon as possible.

Your application form must be lodged at the office by 1st August 2014 for the second instalment.

LATE APPLICATIONS CANNOT BE PROCESSED

Queries relating to eligibility and payments of EMA should be directed to the office.

DUE BY DATES

Please note the importance of adhering to the due by dates for permission notes and payments.

While we do not wish your child to miss an incursion/excursion/camp, late payments make the task of organising events very difficult.

As a result of the recent rain our school grounds are wet and muddy. Parents are encouraged to supply their child with spare clothing in case they get wet or muddy while at school.

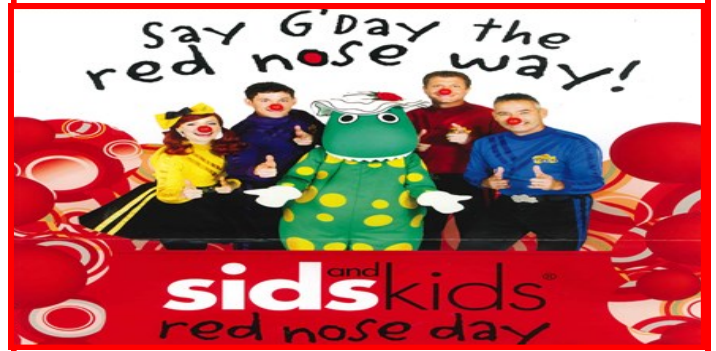
