



This week, small groups of students from Grades 3 – 6 participated in student forums. Working in teams, students discussed two key questions; ‘What helps you learn maths at KPS?’ and ‘What hinders your learning?’ Inviting students to reflect upon their learning, share their perspectives, thoughts and suggestions is part of our commitment to increasing ‘student voice’ at KPS. We will share some student reflections in coming newsletters.

Our Grade 5/6 students have been collecting, representing, comparing, interpreting and analysing different sets of data. Grade 6 students investigated enrolment numbers at three local primary schools over a period of time. Grade 5 students collected data on the colours of cars travelling along Lancefield Road and Conway Street at different times in the day. Which colour do you think was most common? Why?
