


Using the Sentral Parent Portal

Firstly Sign up to the Portal:



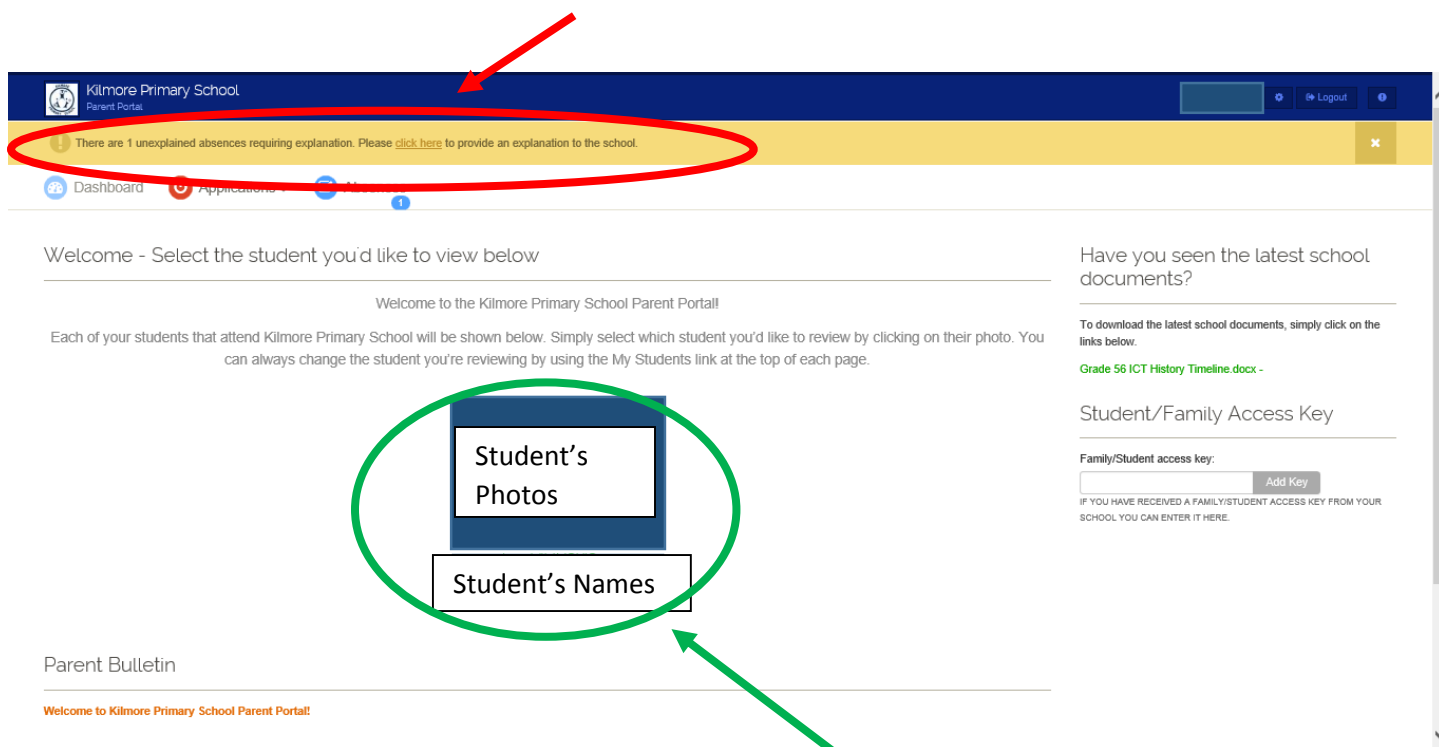

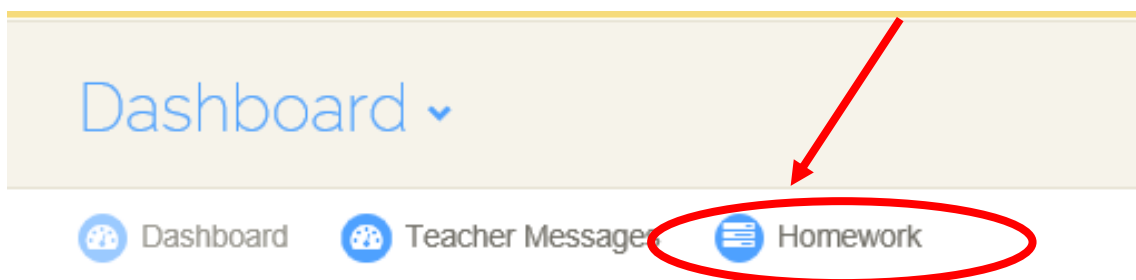

To view homework, click on the homework tab:



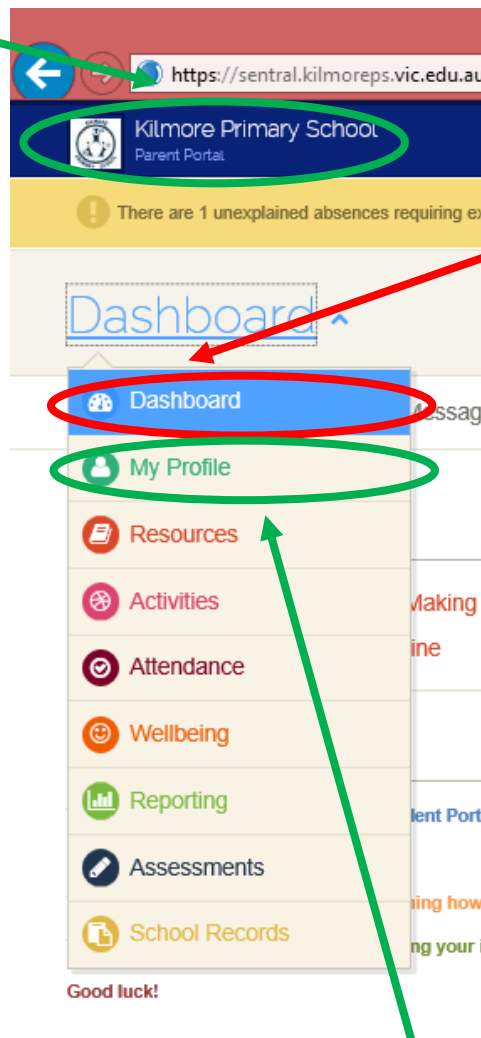
