2020 PARENT OPINION SURVEY

Our school is conducting a survey to find out what parents/guardians think of our school. The Parent Opinion Survey is an annual survey offered by the Department of Education and Training. It is designed to assist schools in gaining an understanding of parents' perceptions of school climate, student behaviour, student engagement and experiences of remote and flexible learning. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

Please check your personal email to see if you have been chosen to participate in the 2020 Parent Opinion Survey. All responses to the survey are anonymous. This year, the Parent Opinion Survey will be conducted from **Monday 12th October** to **Friday 13th November**.

The survey will be conducted **online**, only takes **20 minutes** to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the fieldwork period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in a range of languages other than English. These include: Arabic, Vietnamese, Mandarin, Chin (Hakha), Hindi, Japanese, Somali, Turkish, Punjabi and Greek.

There will be **NO** collection day at the school. Book packs will be delivered free of charge to your child's classroom on the first day of school if payment is received by the due date.

- Online ordering must be done by **MIDNIGHT 11TH DECEMBER 2020** for free delivery to the school.
- Orders placed after this cut-off will be charged a \$5.00 LATE FEE + \$14.95 DELIVERY CHARGE and will be home delivered in January.
- Orders placed after **8th January 2021** are not guaranteed to be delivered prior to the school year commencing.

Ordering can **ONLY** be made through the JI Office Products website, see below for details.

Book Pack, Essential Education Items, Voluntary Financial Contributions and the School Environment Maintenance Program charges are all included on the online form.

Parents can contact the school office for assistance to place the booklist order if they do not have any access to the internet at home.

PLEASE NOTE: All packs will be delivered to the school for distribution to students (or home delivered for late orders) and therefore must be pre-paid.

Payment must be made during the online ordering process, by **Visa or Mastercard only** (credit card or debit card accepted).
